The Shepherds *Ran & Told*

Luke 2:15-20 ^{NIV}

When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, “**Let’s go** to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about.” ¹⁶ So they **hurried off** and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby, who was lying in the manger. ¹⁷ When they had seen him, they **spread the word** concerning what had been told them about this child, ¹⁸ and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds said to them. ¹⁹ But Mary treasured up all these things and pondered them in her heart. ²⁰ The shepherds returned, **glorifying and praising God** for all the things they had heard and seen, which were just as they had been told.





Mary *Treasured & Pondered*

Luke 2:15-20 ^{NIV}
