SIGN GIFTS

Healing

miraculous restoration of health as an act of the Holy Spirit's power and mercy

Tongues

prayer or praise spoken in language not understood by the speaker as enabled by the Holy Spirit

Prophecy

a word from the Lord through a member of his church, inspired by his Spirit and given to build up the rest of the body



1 Corinthians 14:34-36 NIV

Women should remain silent in the churches. They are not allowed to speak, but must be in submission, as the law says. ³⁵ If they want to inquire about something, they should ask their own husbands at home; for it is disgraceful for a woman to speak in the church. ³⁶ Or did the word of God originate with you? Or are you the only people it has reached?



FROM THE LORD

Does it glorify God?

Is it in accord with Scripture?

Does it build up the church?

Is it spoken in love?

Does the speaker submit to judgment by others?

Is the speaker in control of himself or herself?

Does the speaker go on too long?

Is the speaker demonstrating the fruit of the Spirit in his or her life?
