BELONG

What is something that you are known for at work, at home, or with friends?

What has turning to God looked like in your life? What has it meant for you to wait on His Son? In what ways do you sense that you need to turn to God or wait on His Son in a situation or challenge that is before you?

GROW

Read 1 Thessalonians 1:8-10.

What do these verses say that the people of the church in Thessalonica were known for with respect to their Christian faith?

What do you suppose it would have been like for them to have "turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God"? What does this mean for us today? Going Deeper: Who do you know that is involved in spreading the Gospel around the world? How are you (or, how could you be) involved in the global spread of the Gospel? Pause now and pray for a few minutes for those who share the Gospel around the world.

What would your friends say is most important to you in your life? What would they say is your life's goal?

How has this passage helped you see Jesus more clearly?

Take a closer look at verses 9-10. What parts of the Gospel can you point out in these verses?
