EASTER SUNDAY | The Guarantee of the Resurrection

[1 Corinthians 15:20-26, 54-57](#)

Happy Easter! What are some family traditions you associate with Easter?

Read [1 Corinthians 15:3-4](#).

This is the Gospel message as articulated by the Apostle Paul. What are the core elements of the Gospel? Why is the resurrection an important part of the Gospel message?

Read [1 Corinthians 15:20-26](#).

How did death come to the human race through Adam? (If you need to, review Genesis 3:1-7.) How does life come through Jesus Christ? What does it mean that He is the “first fruits” of the resurrection?

Review last week’s passage, [Colossians 2:13-15](#). How does that passage connect to [1 Corinthians 15:24-25](#)? How is the resurrection part of God’s plan for Christ to triumph over these dark powers?

How will death, the last enemy, be destroyed by God?

Read [1 Corinthians 15:54-57](#) aloud.

How does Jesus Christ give us victory over sin and death? Close your time together thanking Him for the truth of this passage and the reality of the resurrection we celebrate each Easter. He is risen! He is risen, indeed!
