What does the crucifixion of Jesus as an event tell us about the problem of sin? How did Jesus going to the cross address the problem of sin?

How was the crucifixion of Jesus a triumph over dark powers? How were those powers put to shame? If the dark powers of sin were defeated on the cross, what does that mean for our lives, city, and world?

What does Jesus' radical offer of forgiveness mean for your life at a heart level? What does it mean for your lifestyle?

As you prepare your heart to remember the sacrifice of Christ on Good Friday and then celebrate the resurrection on Easter, how can your group be praying for you?
