Luke 1:46-56

Review [Luke 1:39-45](#). What is the news Mary is responding to? As a young woman in Jewish culture, what words would you use to describe the emotions she may have felt?

What words are used to describe who God is and what does?

What phrases are used to describe God's faithfulness to Israel in keeping His covenant?

In [verse 46](#), Mary's response to God's redemptive plan through her is a soul that "magnifies" or "glorifies" the Lord, rejoicing in God her Savior. How can we glorify Jesus during this Advent season?

God values both reverent fear and humility as a response to His faithfulness. How can we keep our hearts from being prideful during this Advent season?

Bonus question: Why do you think Mary stayed with Elizabeth for three months before returning home?
