THANKSGIVING SHARE

November 21, 2021

Luke 17:11-19

What's something that you have been especially thankful for in 2021? Is there someone to whom you need to say "thank you"? Share with the group.

Read Luke 17:11-19 aloud.

Why were lepers forced to live outside the community (Leviticus 13:46)?

What was the essence of their cries to Jesus? Mercy or a demand for healing? Have you ever been at a place of asking for God's mercy?

Why did Jesus send them to the priests (Leviticus 14:3-4)?

What was the significance of Jesus pointing out that one of the lepers was a Samaritan—an outcast in Jewish society? Should we assume the other nine were Jews? If so, how do they represent the nation of Israel in their response to Jesus?

Do you think Jesus' response to the Samaritan indicates a deeper, more spiritual blessing than the one received by the other nine?

What does this passage teach us about gratitude? Who in your life might you need to express the blessing of gratitude this week?
